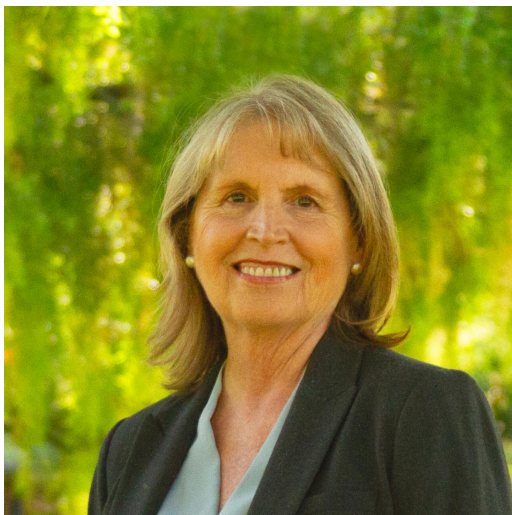

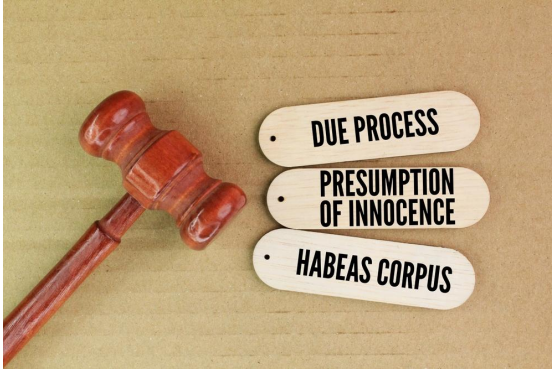

Celebrating the right to freedom of press and standing in solidarity of independent journalism.



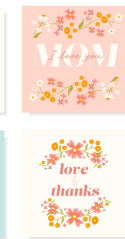
National Nurses Week

## Jewish American Heritage Month

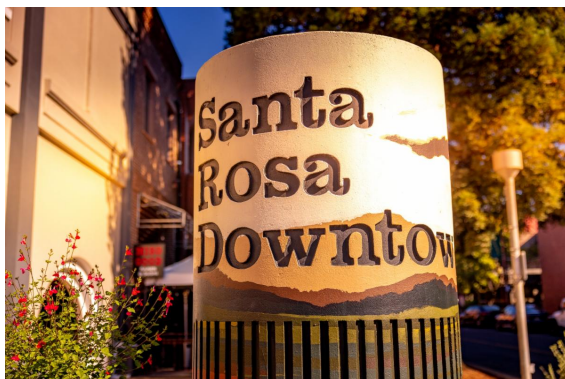
